TRUE BLUE Kitchen Cleaners		
<p><u>TRUE BLUE All Purpose Cleaner</u></p> <p>Pour ½ cup white vinegar in a spray bottle. Add 1 teaspoon of castile soap. Add 1 cup water. Optional: Add 5-10 drops of tea tree oil to combat mold and mildew. Use a damp sponge or cloth.</p>	<p><u>TRUE BLUE Counter Cleaner (Granite, marble, stone)</u></p> <p>Pour 1 cup hot water in a spray bottle. Add 1 teaspoon castile soap Apply and rub off with a microfiber cloth.</p> <p>Do not use vinegar on stone counters.</p>	<p><u>TRUE BLUE Floor Cleaner (Including hardwood floors)</u></p> <p>Pour 1 cup of water in to a spray bottle. Add 1 cup cheap vodka 3-4 drops of castile soap Spray lightly on floor Use a microfiber Mop Do not use vinegar on hardwood floors- it dulls the shine. Do not let water sit on hardwood floors- it damages the wood.</p>

<p><u>TRUE BLUE Oven Cleaner</u></p> <p>Spray oven with water, then sprinkle with baking soda. Spray with water again. Allow to sit overnight. Wipe clean with damp cloth. A reusable non-stick oven liner costs \$20 and makes it easier to clean the bottom of the oven with a damp cloth.</p>	<p><u>TRUE BLUE Drain Cleaner</u></p> <p>Pour ½ cup table salt down the drain. Add ½ cup of baking soda. Pour 1 cup white vinegar into the drain (it will bubble and foam.) If this doesn't work, try a plunger. If that doesn't work, use a plumber's snake. Call a plumber if these methods don't work.</p>

<p><u>TRUE BLUE Toilet Bowl Cleaner</u></p> <p>Put ¼- 1 cup of baking soda in the toilet bowl. Add 1 cup white vinegar. Scrub with brush after fizzing.</p>	<p><u>TRUE BLUE Glass and Mirror Spray</u></p> <p>Pour ½ cup white vinegar in a spray bottle. Add ¼ cup rubbing alcohol Add 1 cup water. Optional: Add a few drops of lemon essential oil for additional degreasing and fragrance. Use microfiber cloth.</p>	<p><u>TRUE BLUE All Purpose Cleaner</u></p> <p>Pour ½ cup white vinegar in a spray bottle. Add 1 teaspoon of castile soap. Add 1 cup water.
